Application of Robert Blinkhorn

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of November A. D. 1924, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7th Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge H. G. Christon presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate sentence of One to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable H. D. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Robert Louis Blinkhorn I was convicted under the name of above
