First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison.
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of June,
A. D. 1916, at Castledale, County of Emery,
and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Five years to Life.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Dist. Atty. Cherry prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Henry Jones.

I was convicted under the name of Henry Jones.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Roy King.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Robbery.
