First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree ^{attempted} Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the second day of June
A. D. 1932, at Edgem County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to terminated sentence. One year
to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.
