Application of David Huwari

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of April, A. D. 1923, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in 7th Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Geo. Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Glen Dale

I was convicted under the name of David Huwari

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Carl K. Lund, & Ollie Peoples

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 2nd degree Burglary
