First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of Sept.  
A. D. 1924, at Brigham City County of Boulder  
and State of Utah, in district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Harris presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve a term of one to  
twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable C. Roy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Noble Hansen

I was convicted under the name of Noble Hansen

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Howard Johnson

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this, and  
truly feel that the straight path is far  
more preferable than any other, and  
that not only has my imprisonment made me  
respect, but it has shown me the value  
of freedom
