I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary third degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of March
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third district Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Cherson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to six months to three years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
Salt Lake City, Utah

Fourth-- Honorable C. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Albert Jensen
I was convicted under the name of Albert Jensen

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary
Prison No. 4211 California
Recommendation-- Three years
Previous record-- San Quentin, California., Oakland, Folsom, California.
