

your mind definitely, because you haven't done that yet-- not to commit this kind of offense any more. In this kind of an offense you not only attempt to take people's property but you are taking their lives in your hands and your own life. It is a wonderful thing in these cases that more people don't get killed, particularly the burglars who enter people's houses. It is made a very serious offense under our statute. So there is only one thing for the Court to do in your case, and that is to see that you stay in the State Prison long enough to definitely make up your mind that you will not do this kind of thing any more.

THE COURT: Have you any reason to give, Mr. Jensen, why the judgment of the Court should be pronounced upon you at this time?

A No sir.

THE COURT: Let the judgment and sentence of the Court be that you be confined in the State Prison of the State of Utah, at hard labor, under the Indeterminate Sentence Act. You are remanded to the custody of the Sheriff of Salt Lake County for the execution of this judgment. I will make such recommendation to the Board of Pardons as I think justice demands in this case, a little later on.
