It has come to my attention that Yorke Van Nixon,
(colored) who was sent to the Utah State Peniten-
tiary for an indeterminate sentence, for assault
and robbery upon the person of myself, October
20th. 1922, has applied for a termination of his
sentence.

I was severely injured during this assault and
suffered greatly for a long period of time, and
I most emphatically and vigorously protest against
the granting of this application. I feel that
justice will not have been done should this
criminal be turned loose to again prey upon
society.
