It has come to my attention that Yorke Van Nixon, (colored) who was sent to the Utah State Penitentiary for an indeterminate sentence, for assault and robbery upon the person of myself, October 20th. 1922, has applied for a termination of his sentence.

I was severely injured during this assault and suffered greatly for a long period of time, and I most emphatically and vigorously protest against the granting of this application. I feel that justice will not have been done should this criminal be turned loose to again prey upon society.
