and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Twenty-seventh day of May
A. D. 1921, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Not less than five and
not more than twenty five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph C. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Herbert Price Adkins
I was convicted under the name of H. P. Adkins.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Joseph Rausch.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Robbery and
Grand Larceny.
