First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison,
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery,

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Twenty-seventh day of May,
A. D. 1921, at Ogden, County of Weber,
and State of Utah, in 2nd. Judicial District, Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Timball, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Five to Twenty-five years,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is, Delbert Price Adkins,
I was convicted under the name of D. P. Adkins,

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: I did not commit the Robbery,

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Robbery and Grand
Larceny.
