Application of Ollie Peoples

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Third day of April
A. D. 1923, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in 7th Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. Christensen, Judge presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Walton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Ollie Peoples
I was convicted under the name of Ollie Peoples

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary
