STATEMENT TO THE BOARD
OF PARDONS.

Gentlemen:

I am herewith submitting my statement of the facts and proceedings in the above entitled cause.

The defendant in this case was, on the 4th day of April, A. D. 1923, arraigned upon the charge of burglary in the second degree and upon his own plea of guilty was, on said day, convicted of said crime. The defendant, waiving time for pronouncing of judgment was, on said 4th day of April, A. D. 1923, sentenced to an indeterminate period of imprisonment in the State Prison of the State of Utah, of not less than one year or more than twenty years.

It appears from the information furnished to the Court that this defendant together with others, one, E. K. Lund, and one, Dave Huveni, were associated with a theatrical troupe then traveling in Emery and Carbon Counties and in connection with their performances some of the company engaged in burglarious efforts, breaking and entering into business houses in Huntington in Emery County, and in Helper in Carbon County, and committed larceny.
