Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of March  
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wm. M. McGree presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of not less than  
one, nor more than ten years,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.
