First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison.
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of March
A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William McCrea presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. J. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Waldo Gibson Chilson
I was convicted under the name of Bob Maxwell

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Military
