Application of Odell Mortensen.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am ~~serving a term of imprisonment~~ on parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of carnal knowledge of female under 18 years.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of October, A. D. 1924, at Castle Dale, County of Emery and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dalworth Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve not to exceed five years in the Utah State Prison, and thereafter was imprisoned in the said Utah State Prison for a period of 3 months when I was paroled to my father George Q. Mortensen, about March, 1925.

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Odell Mortensen. I was convicted under the name of Odell Mortensen.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
