I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence,
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of November
A. D. 1924, at Price County of Carbon
and State of Utah, in 7th Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Twenty Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Stanley Earl Mapwell
I was convicted under the name of Stanley Earl Mapwell

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this
