Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of April
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake,
and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term in
Utah State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Benjamin Holt
I was convicted under the name of Sam.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: "None"

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except "None"
