Application of George B Holt

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of April
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Dist Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to ten years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
until I was paroled out in Dec. 20 - 1924.

Fourth-- Honorable E A Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Benjamin Holt
I was convicted under the name of George B Holt

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except This one
