On March 25, 1924, this defendant entered a plea of guilty to Embezzlement, and on the 28th he was sentenced indeterminately. I recommend one year in the Penitentiary for him.

He was intrusted with about \$300. worth of property of one David Bogans, and instead of taking it to the place where he agreed to take it he went to a pawnshop with it and pawned it as his own property for about \$20. He appears to be a man of previous good reputation, having worked for the railroad for the past fifteen years in various capacities. He is colored.
