Dear Sir's,

I am writing you these few lines in explaining my case to the Honorable Board. As I were working on the Rail Road from Dec. up until March. I came to Ogden to have my feet worked on for frozen feet. I met one Joe Bogarus about three days after I reached Ogden. He came to me saying that he wanted me to take his trunk and put it away for him until he calls for it, which I then did. Put his trunk in Jawn's Shop. At that time I were waiting for my money from the Rail Road. Which I didn't get from time. So I ask the Prop. about getting Eight dollars on the trunk. Mustell I get my money. Which he let me have. After having as witness, Detective Robert Chambers. But before I got my money. The Bogarus the owner of the trunk came for it.
