I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Twenty third day of May
A. D. 1923, at Ogden City County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate Sentence
(namely One to twenty years)
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
at Salt Lake City.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George V. Clark

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except when a
