and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District, Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge William H. Knox, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Twenty years, in the Utah State Prison,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

I was convicted under the name of G. J. Bliss,
