Application of Zella Carter Walker

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of sale of intoxicating liquor

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of March  
A. D. 1924, at Parowan County of Iron  
and State of Utah, in the District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Thomas A. Burton presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to six months in the County Jail of Salt Lake  
County, State of Utah  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail of Salt Lake County, State  
of Utah

Fourth-- Honorable W. H. Higgins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Zella Carter Walker  
I was convicted under the name of Zella Carter walker

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: my co-defendant Marian Carter

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except

County Jail.
