A. D. 1922., at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake.
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L.B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term--
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E.A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is A.E. Harrison.

I was convicted under the name of do do

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: L.E. Riggs, and E.C. Clark.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except This One.

Note - Applicant was paroled December 26th, 1924.
