Application of Charles Smith

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21 day of July
A. D. 1924, at Provo County of Utah
and State of Utah, in fourth Dist Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dist Judge Elias Hansen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
from one to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Marcelius Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles Smith
I was convicted under the name of Charles Smith

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Andrew Lurant and Reuben Gonzales

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except a charge of
burglary in Montana in the year 1900.

I wish to go to Wyoming.
