Application of Thomas Moore

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison of Utah
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of robbery and Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of April
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas Moore
I was convicted under the name of Thomas Moore

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: John King

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except selling intoxicants
for which I was fined and paid the fine.
