Application of Conditional Pardon

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows: to go home to my Mother in Portland

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of April
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Utah State Prison for a term of
five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is James Linzi
I was convicted under the name of Thomas Moore

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: John King and not unknown

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except a felony in
the State of Washington
