I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination.  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the eighth day of September  
A. D. 1925, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in the second judicial district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James N. Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from  
one to twenty years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Thomas Patrick Moore  
I was convicted under the name of Thomas Moore

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: James Monroe

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except what is shown on  
the records
