Application of G. Espino.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with Deadly Weapon

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of March A. D. 1923, at Price, Utah County of Carbon and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Wooley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 1 to 5 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Condellario Espino. I was convicted under the name of Condellario Espino
