Application of William B. Eaton.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of April  
A. D. 1923, at Provo, County of Grand  
and State of Utah, in Utah, 7th District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Dillworth Wasley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison on  
the 9th day of April - 1923

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Young of Box Elder County prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Britain Eaton.

I was convicted under the name of William Britain Eaton.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: No one

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary - this  
being my third time here. I have a great  
desire to be able to appear in person before
