I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of April  
A. D. 1923, at Moab County of Grand  
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial Dist. Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Dilworth W. Cole presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Serve a term of 6 months  
to 3 years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
on the 16th day of April 1923

Fourth-- Honorable Leroy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Wm. B. Eaton  
I was convicted under the name of Wm. B. Eaton

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except in this state.
