County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one to ten years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. Evans prosecuted the case.

I was convicted under the name of Albert Edward Beavers

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
