Application of Albert E. Beaver

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a <sup>Rehearing of</sup> Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21 day of June A. D. 1924, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in the 2nd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James R. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to not less than one year and not more than ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Albert E. Beaver. I was convicted under the name of Albert E. Beaver.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: John McVickers

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except This one
