Application of John Greb

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of October A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Richie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of One to Twenty Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Greb
I was convicted under the name of John Hall

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Albert Wade

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this.
