and State of Utah, in Second Dist. Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. N. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of
from five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Jos. Evans prosecuted the case.
