for Brown. It was claimed by Rolland and Lindsley that Brown was the instigator. Rolland was a stranger in Ogden and seems to have been a wanderer from place to place. Lindsley had been in trouble before and an inmate of the Industrial School, and my impression is he was paroled from that institution at the time of the commission of this robbery.

There seems to have been no mitigating circumstances in this case and my recommendation is that these defendants be retained in prison for at least the full period of five years.
