Application of Joe Ritchie #4288

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder Second Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of October A. D. 1923, at Tooele, Utah County of Tooele and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable William S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to 10 Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Joe Ritchie

I was convicted under the name of Joe Ritchie

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the one for which I am now serving.
