To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21 day of February
A. D. 1922, at Brigham City County of Beaver
and State of Utah, in First District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Justice Law presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison, and
July 11, 1923, being out on bond up to that
time for an appeal.

Fourth-- Honorable J. Roy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frank A. Angle
I was convicted under the name of Frank Angle.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: C. C. Monroe

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand.
