Referring to your letter of June 4th concerning the case of Frank Angle and C. C. Monroe, joint defendants and appellants in case No. 3851 in the Supreme Court of Utah, I beg to advise you that these two men were found guilty of grand larceny in the First Judicial District Court, the late Justin D. Call and B. C. Call appearing for the defendants.

In my opinion they were given a fair and impartial trial, and it is my further opinion that the facts as shown by the evidence fully justify the verdict. The case was appealed to the Supreme Court and there affirmed, and a petition for rehearing has been filed. I am informed that the petition for rehearing is being held up pending the outcome of the illness of one of the defendants' wives.
