Application of Tom O'Donnell

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of Sept. A. D. 1925, at Ogden, Utah, County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Timmings presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve term 6 months to 3 yrs and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Attorney L. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Tom O'Donnell I was convicted under the name of same

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Return School Gun
