and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the eight day of Sept
A. D. 1915, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Six months to Three years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Tom O'Donnell.

I was convicted under the name of " ".

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except a term of
seven months in the Colorado Reform School.
