Application of Tommy O'Donnell

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3<sup>rd</sup> District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison for one year

Fourth-- Honorable C. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Tommy O'Donnell  
I was convicted under the name of Tommy O'Donnell

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: \_\_\_\_\_

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Burglary in the State of Utah. Sept 9<sup>th</sup> 1925
