Application of Tomy O'Donnell No. 4852

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination (Conditional that I go to my Mother in New Mexico.) and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of April, A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.
