Application of Tommy O'Donnell

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional termination
and respectfully represent as follows: to leave the State.

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of third degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of April
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in third district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 6 months to three years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth-Honorable C. J. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Tommy O'Donnell
I was convicted under the name of Tommy O'Donnell

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except once in
Utah prior to my present incarceration.
