Application of Tommy O'Donnell, No.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of April A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake, and State of Utah, in the third Judicial District, Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve from six months to three years. and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary.

Fourth-Honorable Prosecutor Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Tommy O'Donnell, I was convicted under the name of Tommy O'Donnell.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

I would like to go home to my mother, who lives in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except once before, here.

I will thank you most sincerely to let me go at this time.
