First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of April
A. D. 1923, at Castle Dale County of Emery
and State of Utah, in the Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable District Attorney Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Allen C. Reichelbauer

I was convicted under the name of Allen C. Reichelbauer

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Second degree burglary
and served two years in California State Prison year 1921.
