I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second degree burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of March  
A. D. 1923, at Castle Dale County of Emery  
and State of Utah, in the Judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable District Attorney Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Allen C. Reichelbauer

I was convicted under the name of "A. C. Reichelbauer"

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except being  
2nd degree burglary and served two years in California  
State Prison near 1921.
