Application of Byron G. Foss

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination - conditional  
and respectfully represent as follows: that I leave the State if preferred.

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December  
A. D. 1924, at Price County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in the 7<sup>th</sup> Judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Utah State Prison

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison on  
March 21, 1925. was on bond for a while  
after conviction.

Fourth-- Honorable George Constantine prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Byron Grant Foss  
I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none whatever
