

Affidavit of Byron G. Foss,
to the
Honorable Board of Pardons,
State of Utah:

Salt Lake City, Utah.
June 23, 1925.

I, Byron G. Foss, do solemnly swear that the following are true facts:

- 1.- I have made application to your Hon. Body for a Conditional Termination, so that I may go to my home and folks, in California.
- 2.- My home conditions are ideal and I am wanted and needed there. My mother and young brother are dependent upon Mother's own earnings. It is my sincere wish, to again be in a position to help them.
- 3.- I have an exceptionally fine position awaiting me, just as soon as I reach California. I can go to work immediately, which I wish to do.
- 4.- I have a newly tailored suit, just finished for me by the Prison tailor, and fully paid for. I also have approximately one hundred dollars, (\$100.00), in the Prison office. If permitted to return to my home and awaiting position, I shall have no financial difficulties to retard me, and will be able to return well dressed and with sufficient funds to assure my transportation and maintenance.
- 5.- I was convicted on a charge of Carnal Knowledge, and the Court recommended 90 days imprisonment at the State Prison. I have exceeded that time, here. I also served practically six
